- Focus shows at performance venues as assigned.
- Run dimmer and lamp checks with Lighting Director/Assistant Head Electrician as assigned.
- Work with Lighting Director to maintain all web cards and deck sheets.
- Cover other key positions as required.
- Maintain an accurate and up to date hardware and equipment inventory.
- Serve as running crew for all assigned FGO performances.
- Maintain a safe and efficient working environment.
- Must carry him/herself in a calm and professional manner during all stage calls and performances.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS: Comprehensive knowledge of theatrical lighting practices.
Must have ETC lighting console knowledge.
Must be computer literate with familiarity of Lightwright, Microsoft Word, and Excel.
Must have working knowledge of electrical theories and practices.
